

Clarification on Installation of BBQ's – Hard Piped vs. Portable

The issue:

How do we treat barbeques and related piping when taking a permit

Business Rule 1: If it is a hard piped barbeque such as a barbeque pit this is considered an appliance and should be permitted as such. Select Appliance Type '15 – Barbeque'

Business Rule 2: If it's a portable barbeque that requires installation of piping and a quick connector type of box we only consider the piping – we really cannot regulate the barbeque per se because it is a portable device. If installing piping for a portable BBQ, it is not considered an appliance or selection from the drop down but must be noted in the Direction/Mapping and Notes field as 'piping for portable bbq' and no fee is charged for this **as long as other appliances or piping are requested for the permit.**
